- Testing in 2017, over 15 regions in 2018 pilot





The test technology developed by SensDx facilitates quick identification of specific diseases and allows the user to:

- obtain precise information about the type of a developing condition
- establish a precise diagnosis
- commence the right therapy

Post-stroke Monitoring Service for Patients and HCPs



- tool to allow post-stroke patients with difficulty walking to undergo self-rehabilitation at home, with remote follow up from a therapist
- Web-based solution that will reduce the rehabilitation costs by 35%
- Implementation will be simple due to integrated approach of tool for HCPs




Interactive Hydration Controller




- Wearable textile band to monitor the level of hydration in physically active people, young children and seniors





Fostering innovation to improve people's health


- **Who can apply?** Project Leaders must be a legal individual with tertiary qualifications (university graduates, professor or doctor).
- **Other European countries are also encouraged to apply with projects**

CaixaImpulse is an intensive acceleration programme for the **creation of new products and companies in the health and life sciences sector**. This programme is meant to start the translation of health research projects into a market product.

Caixa is looking to support projects for researchers from **universities, research and technology transfer centres, hospitals, foundations and non-profit institutions**, whose main activity is research from Spain and Portugal. Established companies are explicitly excluded.


Validate line places emphasis on validating products and services.

Our network of Living Labs and Test Beds provides entrepreneurs the means to test products throughout the value chain.

Other activities allow entrepreneurs to gain understanding in local/regional regulatory and reimbursement schemes and have access to market experts.

InnoStars Awards for startups with a MVP or strong idea

Training and competition program for early stage companies and SMEs that provides you European level publicity! Receive € 8 000 none-dilutive funding as smart money for business development, product validation, business plan writing and win awards up to € 25.000 to further develop your MVP or Prototype.




Headstart funding



- The purpose of the Headstart funding is to accelerate market entry and create new economic activity.
 - Best Headstart startups may received additional selected training at the Innostars startup academy
- The EIT Health Headstart Funding Programme is suitable for micro and small enterprises*, spin-offs, and start-ups that have a well-developed prototype and are ready to launch a product. Company must be incorporated/registered before the subgranting agreement initiation*
- Provides **funding of up to € 50,000** for early stage companies and SMEs to develop new products and services. These should fit within the overall EIT Health objective: **“Healthy Living, Active Ageing, Improved Health Care.”**
 - To support the applicants in realizing next steps towards market and shorten time-to-market for innovative products and services
 - To verify the need/benefit of the product/service for users/customers/payers/ partners
 - To increase the possibility of attracting further private investment

Boost health entrepreneurs



These activities focus on more mature startups and SMEs, to facilitate access to tools and networks for financing and market expansion.



- European Health Catapult is a **training and competition programme dedicated for incorporated companies in MedTech/BioTech/Digital Health.**
- The program brings together international investors and entrepreneurs behind some of Europe's most promising health innovations in Medtech, Biotech and Digital Health categories

- **Stage 1:**

- Regional selection. Selected startups will participate in the Innostars startup academy

- **Stage 2:**

- Centralised training and selection days held before 15 October 2018 for each of the three categories
 - Biotech – Leuven, 24 – 26 September 2018
 - Medtech – Grenoble, 1 – 3 October 2018.
 - Digital Health – Erlangen, 8 – 10 October 2018
- 2 days training with mentors/experts to mature your BP and prepare to pitch in front of investors / Peer to peer connection
- 1 day to connect with potential investors and EIT Health industry partners

- **Stage 3:**

- Final selection during **EIT Health Summit, 4-5 December 2018 in Lodz.**
- Prizes and European visibility – network ++



GoGlobal - Safety Belt to Go2China

- Soft landing program to China (Shenzhen province) for mature start-ups and SME's that provides you insider knowledge, access to VCs, key decision makers and top level Shenzhen Government exposure.
- Who can apply? A mature start-up or young company that has the ambition to **expand on the international market**, companies should already have valuable international partnerships, strong references or sales in their home company.



• FreshBlood HealthTech Community


- Started in Autumn 2016 as a healthtech community in Cluj-Napoca, Transylvania, Romania

- Support for university run innovation programs:

Vision:

- People already dependent on the system have a limited availability to try something new/innovate
- You have to find and expose them when they are still relatively independent – hence students/young specialists/resident doctors


